



## COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS: 2008

**Eligibility:** Children of any PLUS member or employee of a PLUS corporate sponsor company.  
(Ex. Children of support staff are eligible even if their parent is not a direct registered member of PLUS.)  
Applicants must be in their senior year of high school at time of application.

**Applications & Deadlines:** Applications available online January 1, 2008. Applications due March 15.

**Leo Gilmartin Scholarship:** Awarded for scholastic merit and extracurricular activity. Application requirements include, but are not limited to:

- College entrance exam scores
- G.P.A. and class rank
- Essay and letters of recommendation
- List of extracurricular and community service activities
- Recipients will be required to present evidence of full time attendance and meet GPA requirements in order to be eligible for funds the following year

**PLUS Foundation Financial Aid Grants:** Awarded based on family financial need and proof of average to above average high school performance. Application requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Household adjusted gross income
- Total number in household and number of dependent children attending college
- Estimated cost of tuition
- G.P.A., class rank, college entrance exams scores
- Recipients will be required to present evidence of full time attendance and meet GPA requirements in order to be eligible for funds the following year
- The amount of financial aid paid to recipients will be recalculated annually based on updated family financial information
- Note: These applications are handled by a third-party administrator and all information is kept confidential. No PLUS members or staff will have access to this information.

### **General Details & Requirements for Both Scholarships:**

- Up to four scholarships will be awarded in each category (Gilmartin, Financial Aid).
- Scholarships will be for up to \$10,000 each, payable in increments over four years.
- Applicants must be a child of a current PLUS member or a child of an employee of a current PLUS corporate sponsor.
- An applicant is required to be in his/her senior year of high school.
- A recipient must successfully complete high school and enroll in an accredited four year college or university in the Fall.
- A student may be eligible and apply for both scholarships, but can only be awarded one.
